

What: The Catechesis of the Good Shepherd Level I Formation Course

This Level I Course presents essential elements of our faith appropriate for the 3-6 year old through the prepared environment "the Atrium" and the CGS materials. These include presentations such as the announcement of GOD's love (in the person of the Good Shepherd, who died and has risen); materials on the life of Christ and his teachings (the geography materials establish Jesus as a real person in time and space and Israel as the land through which GOD realized salvation for all); infancy narratives announce the Incarnation with the words of Scripture; selected parables serve as keys to unlock the mystery of the kingdom of GOD; the cenacle; the baptism; and articles of the mass (altar and tabernacle). The course also adult reflections, practice time, and material making. The course is primarily English but the Formation Leader is fluent in Spanish, Portuguese and German for specific dialogue and questions. Lunch is on your own but morning and afternoon snacks are included.
